COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

June 30th, 2026

I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 2:01 PM

II. Roll Call - Attendance:

III. Approval of Agenda: The agenda was approved as amended with the addition of item b) purchase of Drollinger's service weapon.

Motion by Boyd, seconded by McPherson to approve the agenda as presented. Motion Passed by unanimous voice vote.

IV. Approval of Minutes – March 17th, 2026: The minutes of the March 17th, 2026 meeting were approved as presented.

Motion by McPherson, seconded by Boyd to approve the March 17th, 2026 meeting minutes as presented. Motion Passed by unanimous voice vote.

VIII. New Business

a. Police Car Purchase:

Chief Fisher presented the approximate quote and options for the purchase of a new police car. A discussion was made regarding the CD in the amount of \$38,921.58 for the Police Car Purchase. Chief Fisher states the approximate total cost of the vehicle would be around \$55k- \$60k. A discussion was made regarding the installation of Police equipment on the new police vehicle to be completed by Mr. Drollinger in return of a credit on his water bill. A discussion was made to amend the budget to allow an additional \$15k into the Capital Outlay in the Police fund to bring the total Capital Outlay fund to \$25k.

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Motion by McPherson, second by Boyd to recommend to council to amend the Police Budget Capital Outlay from the approved \$5- \$10K to \$25k for the purchase of a new police vehicle. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Motion by Boyd, second by McPherson to recommend to council to allow Mr. Drollinger to install the equipment on the new Police vehicle in return for a \$2,000 credit on his water bill. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Motion by Boyd, second by McPherson, to recommend to council to allow Chief Fisher to get the official quote for the New Police Vehicle and move forward with the purchasing process. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

b. Purchase of Drollinger Service Weapon:

Mr. Drollinger has requested to purchase his service weapon upon his retirement from the Village of Bellaire.

Motion by Boyd, second by McPherson, to recommend to council to allow Mr. Drollinger to purchase his service weapon at fair market value following the Village of Bellaire's Policy upon his retirement. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
